FAQ's

What does a Habitat home cost?

- Homes are purchased at fair market value
- Mortgages are 0% (interest free)
- Mortgage payments are geared to 25% of gross monthly income

What does a Partner Family have to contribute towards their home?

- Partner Families contribute 500 hours of their Sweat Equity as down payment for their home.
- Partner Families complete 3 levels of training.
- Partner Families have to cover their own legal fees and land transfer taxes.
- Partner Families have to bring all of their own furnishings, window coverings, etc.
- Partner Families have to assume the responsibility of not just the mortgage but home maintenance as well.
